About Us

Sree Ayyappa College for Women came into existence in the year 1970. The institution established with the motto, "Siksha Dharmena Shobathe" (Education Sparkles through Moral Excellence) is run by Sree Ayyappa Educational Society. The Society formed by the Malayalam speaking linguistic minority of Kanyakumari District and registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1955 founded a junior college for men in the year 1969. But as the greater need was for the higher education of women students, the Management with the consent of the affiliated Madurai University converted the institution into a women' college in the next year. The college was vested with linguistic minority status in 1987. It is a boon not only to the young women students of linguistic minority but also to students of all disadvantaged communities. The college is situated at the foot of Velimalai, the tail end of Western Ghats. The tranquillity and serenity of the idyllic surroundings provides congenial atmosphere for academic pursuits. Located close to the National Highways at a distance of 7 kilometres from Nagercoil, students gain easy access to transport facilities.

Re-accredited with B Grade by NAAC, the college offers graduate courses in Arts and Science subjects and Commerce, post-graduate courses in English, Mathematics and Commerce and M.Phil. courses in English and Commerce. Department of English got upgraded to a Research Centre in 2012. The institution trumpeting five decades of academic tradition glides along with the help and guidance of the Nair Service Society, the blessings of its founder, late Padmabhooshan Mannathu Padmanabhan and the good will and patronage of the public.



APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Application for admission to B.A/B.Sc/B.Com/M.A/M.Sc/M.Com/M.phil courses should be given in the prescribed form which will be issued from the college office on payment of Rs. 48/- in person or Rs. 60/- by M.O.for U.G. and Rs. 48/- in person or Rs. 58/- by M.O. for P.G. Full address of the applicant, course and branch for which admission is sought should be clearly stated in the M.O. coupon, if application is sought through M.O.

Filled in applications should be registered in the college office by paying Rs. 2/- within 10 working days from the date of publication of the results of the examination qualifying for admission. The registration card obtained from the college office at the time of registration should be produced for all enquiries regarding the application.

If a candidate wishes to apply for more than one major subject, she will have to give the order of preference in the application form.

Selection list is prepared following the reservation rules prescribed by the government. Lists of candidates selected to the various courses and of candidates in the Waiting List shall be displayed on the college Notice Board on the 15th day after the publication of the results of the qualifying Examinations. Candidates who are provisionally selected and those in the Waiting List.



Should appear for an interview with their parents/guardian before the Principal on the date and time specified. Candidates selected for admission will have to remit the prescribed fee immediately in the college office, failing which they will lose their claim for admission.

At the time of interview, candidate should produce the following:-

- 1) Certificates proving qualification and age.
- 2) T.C. and Conduct Certificate.
- 3) Community Certificates in the case of BC/MBC/SC/ST candidates.
- 4) Certificates to prove the eligibility for selection under the quotas, physically handicapped / sports / NCC / Ex.Service men.
- 5) Two photostat copies of the Mark Statement of the Qualifying Examination.

NOTE:

4.3, "Admission is subject to verification of mark certificate issued by the Director of Government Examination and if the mark certificate is found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancellation besides criminal action being taken". The college also provides facilities to the students to undergo Certificate courses in Information Technology and Tally, and Spoken English course.

EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF FEE

- 1. SC/ST/MBC and other Denotified Community students are exempted from payment of tuition fee irrespective of their parental income. They are expected to produce Community Certificate from an officer of the revenue department not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar stating clearly the community to which they belong. SC/ST students are also exempted from payment of fee for application form for admission. Payment is to be made for every additional application form purchased. They should bring community certificate original for verification and an attested copy of the certificate for submission to the college office.
- 2. Tuition fee will be refunded to OC students, if the annual income of their parent is below Rs. 24000/- (Income Certificate from the Tahsildar/Deputy Tahsildar should be produced at the time of admission) Special Fee covers items like Calendar, Magazine Students Association, Audio visual Education, Student's aid Fund, Medical Inspection, College Day, Library & Reading Room, Sports & Games and Stationary for examinations etc.

If selected for admission students from other Universities, will have to get the Eligibility certificate from the University by paying the prescribed fee. They must produce the certificate in original along with the other certificates of the qualifying examination at the time of admission.

The fee for the year will be collected as follows:

Tuition fees, in two equal instalments, one in each semester.

Laboratory fee: With the instalment of tuition fee in each semester.

Special fee: At the time of admission.

Students shall not be permitted to attend classes until the first inst alment of fee is paid. Students who are found to have obtained admission by false representation shall be summarily dismissed with forefeiture of whatever fee they may have paid.



NOTE:

Applicants are informed that the original certificates (Higher Secondary Grade Certificate etc.) produced by them at the time of admission will be retained in the college and will not be returned under any circumstances before the completion of the course. Hence they are advised to take sufficient number of copies of these certificates before submitting them to the college office.

SCHOLARSHIP AND FEE CONCESSIONS:

Students will be granted fee concessions and Scholarships as per Government rules in force on production of required certificates signed by the competent authority. Deserving students will get financial assistance from the student's Aid Fund. Hostel facility is available.
